- Advance reservations are required. A fee is charged for Tour & Tea. Dates are usually booked in advance.
- The group assembles at 1:30 pm in the nave.
- The tour provides an in-depth look at the Cathedral's art, architecture, and history or may highlight a particular subject, such as stained glass or the gardens.
- Following the tour, tea is served in the St. Paul Room, a beautiful wood-paneled room with magnificent views of the city.
- The tea fare includes scones, sweets, and tea sandwiches.
- Following tea, participants are invited to attend Evensong or Evening Prayer at 5:30 pm.
- Tea attendees receive a discount in the Herb Cottage gift shop on the day of the tea.
